## Child Care Center and School of Education

- The school of education will be limited to grades kindergarten through 812th grade, with a maximum daily enrollment of 4300 students.
- The <u>child care</u> center will be limited to a maximum daily enrollment of 4200 children. \*
  - Current: (Total 200 students)
    - Preschool :100 students & K-8<sup>th</sup> grade: 100 Students
  - Amendment for this year.
    - Preschool: 200 students & K-8<sup>th</sup> grade: 300 students

## **UPDATES**

- 1. Enhanced Safety Precautions
  - a. In addition to the regular church security that was already in place the School has hired an additional security company whose expertise pertains to schools.
  - b. The School installed door locks which allow the teachers to lock the door from the inside.
  - c. The School includes fire, lock down and shelter in place drills as part of their security protocols.
  - d. Security cameras have been installed that monitor the entire school building zone.
- 2. Equity and Inclusion
  - a. The School will allow outside resource teachers to provide in-person services at the family's request on a case-by-case basis.
- 3. Accommodations for differing student ages
  - a. The School has converted one of the church areas to accommodate all middle schoolers ensuring they will be apart from the younger students. Middle schoolers will have different schedules (classes, lunch, chapel, PE), and have teachers identified by subject area versus one teacher per class.
  - b. The School is presently a member of the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and are undergoing accreditation with both ACSI and Cognia organizations. The Curriculum will follow the Bob Jones University curriculum. The School is also planning on hiring a guidance counselor to provide aid to the students and track their progression.
  - c. The School will also implement the TADS system which allow for students and parents to access homework, grades, and other school materials at all times.
