### Transit Elements of Our Proposal

- Investments in infrastructure to support current and future transit operations

  - 28-mile extension of HOV/HOT/Bus system
  - Connection with Phase VIII/Capital Beltway HOT lanes

- Six new Park & Rides
- Enhancements to 12 existing bus stops/stations along the corridor


### Communication & Public Outreach




