MODIFIED CODE CHANGES

- Proposed code changes were modified to address issues raised by BOS
- Length changed to 21 ft. instead of 20 ft.
- Clarified Sec. 82-5-7 to focus on commercial vehicle definition/restrictions distinct from CPDs (but some overlap)
- Exempts vehicles on business, moving vehicles (e.g., U-hauls for 48 hrs.), vehicles transporting persons with disabilities, some others
